Rather than selling guards from one vendor, cameras from another and monitoring from a third, Knightscope delivers autonomous machines, AI-driven software and licensed security agents as a single managed service, under one contract, one escalation path and one accountable entity.

Headquartered in Sunnyvale, California, the Company is American-owned and controlled, operates only in the United States and answers to public-company governance: audited financials and an independent board. Knightscope holds a FedRAMP Moderate Authority to Operate for federal deployments and is bringing its end-to-end system to FedRAMP High and Department of Defense Impact Level 5 cybersecurity standards for every client, federal or commercial.

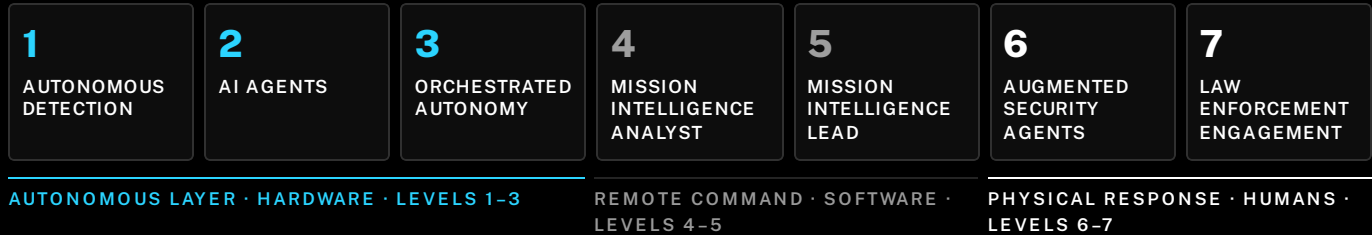

Seven levels. Three layers. One Force. An accountable human holds escalation authority at every level, every hour of every day.

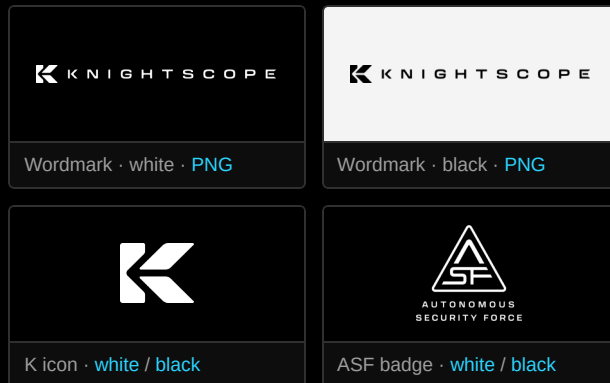

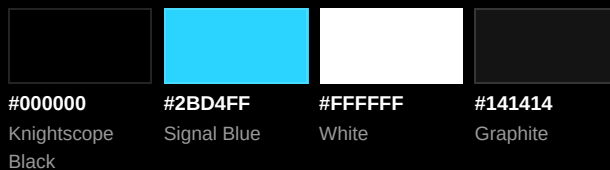

Editorial style guide

Company name: Knightscope, or Knightscope, Inc. on first reference. One word, capital K only.

The Force: Autonomous Security Force on first reference; "the Force" thereafter. Knightscope is a managed service provider, not a robot manufacturer.

People: "licensed security agents" or "security agents," never "guards." Remote operators are "Mission Intelligence Analysts" and "Mission Intelligence Leads."

Clients: Knightscope serves "clients," not "customers."

Products: K1 Capsule, K1 Hemisphere, K1 Super Tower, K5 ASR, K7 ASR (ASR = Autonomous Security Robot), H1 Augmented Security Agent, Signals. "K5" and "K7" are acceptable on second reference.

Structure: ASF-7 is the seven-level, three-layer escalation model. Levels 1–3 hardware, 4–5 software and Mission Intelligence, 6–7 licensed physical response.

Privacy: Knightscope's stated position is "privacy for the innocent, no hiding place for the wanted." Detections are matched against known threats; everything is logged with a full audit trail.
